How we work

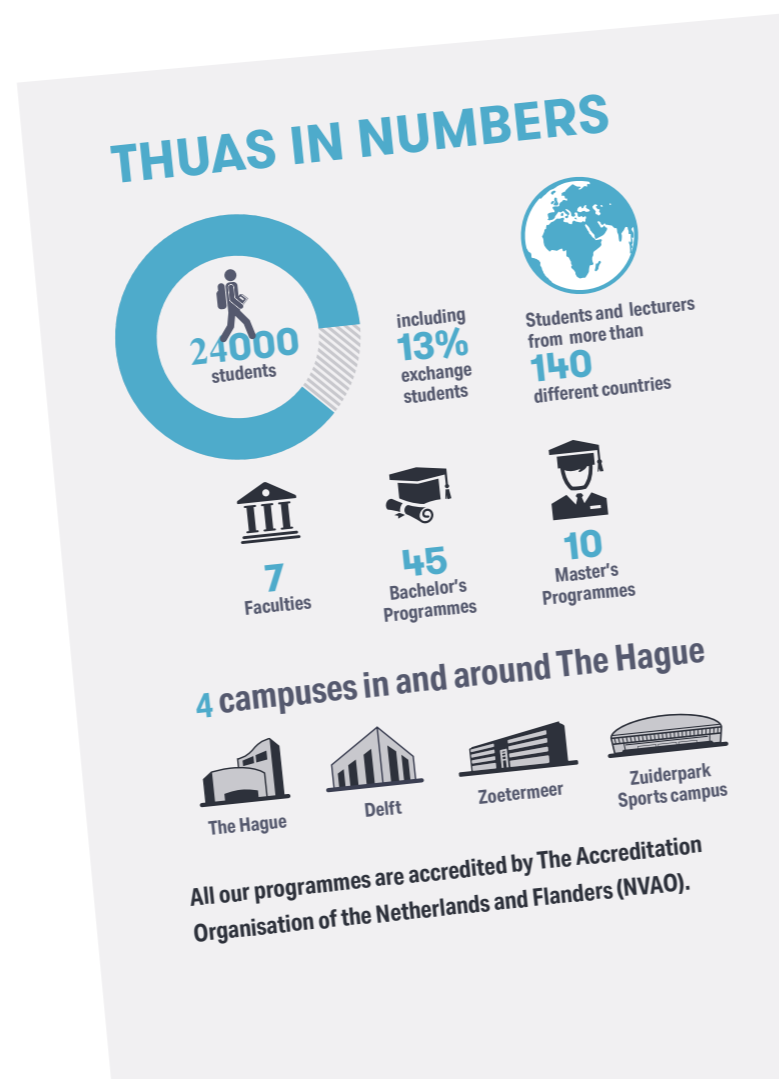

General entry requirements

Bachelor's programmes

Students require the equivalent of a Dutch system HAVO or VWO diploma to apply for a bachelor's programme. The assessment of the eligibility of our prospective students holding a non-Dutch diploma are based on the diploma recognitions of the Nuffic www.nuffic.nl.

Entry requirements for master's programmes vary according to the course. Aside from academic and language requirements, some programmes require a minimum of two years of relevant work experience.

OUR BACHELOR'S PROGRAMMES

Applied Computer Science (3 years)

As part of this course, you'll have the opportunity to specialise as an (Embedded) Software Engineer or an Information & Cyber Security expert

Electrical and Electronic Engineering (3 years)

In this programme you will work on real-world projects and learn how to design, develop, and apply electrical systems across various industries

European Studies (3 or 4 years)

Follow a career in European policy and international marketing equipped with the right international communication skills.

Industrial Design Engineering (3 years)

In this programme you learn how to design smart, sustainable products that will improve the lives of those using them.

International and European Law (4 years)

This programme will train you to give legal advice to public and private clients in an international legal setting.

International Business (3 years)

This programme gives students a solid grounding in economics, marketing, sales, finance and management skills.

International Communication Management (3 years)

This programme will equip you for a career in external and internal communication.

International Financial & Management Control (3 or 4 years)

Study business economics with a view to becoming a financial controller, project manager or risk manager.

International Public Policy and Leadership (4 years)

Want to help fix international governmental issues? Join the dialogue on the administrative level with this degree programme.

International Sport Management (3 years)

This programme will equip you with the necessities you'll need as an international sports manager, such as: sports marketing, sports policy and the impact of sports on society.

Process & Food Technology (3 years)

Combine science and technology with hands-on projects to go on to work in an international manufacturer of household goods

Safety and Security Management Studies (4 years)

This programme focuses on the safety and security of people, organisations and public spaces.

User Experience Design (3 years)

In this programme, you design digital experiences that are intuitive and engaging by combining technology, and creative problem-solving.

Master of Business Administration (MBA)

Our MBA will sharpen your business acumen and strategic skills to help you build a career as a manager or executive.

Master in Data Driven Business (MA)

Help organizations progress by using data smartly—bridging technical experts and decision-makers to deliver insights and strategic solutions.

Master Financial Management and Control (MSc)

Develop the skills you need to work in the financial services and banking sectors with a view to becoming a chief financial officer.

Master International Communication Management (MA)

Learn how to develop, implement and manage complex communication strategies.

Learn all the necessary tools you need as 'the engineer of the future', to face identified societal challenges like climate change, the ageing workforce and increased demand for healthcare.

Master in Quantum Technology

Tuition fees and scholarships

EU/EEA and non-EU/EEA students are expected to pay tuition fees for bachelors and masters programmes, but there are many loans, grants and scholarships available to help you finance your studies. Check if any scholarships are available in your home country. Your local Dutch embassy and present college or university should be able to help. It's also worth checking to see if you are eligible for the Holland Scholarship. EU/EEA bachelors students pay €2,601 per year and most non-EU/EEA pay €10,164. Tuition fees for masters can vary. Please visit www.thuas.com/tuitionfees to check our current tuition fees.

The Hague Summer School offers a one-off fee which covers all of your main costs including tuition, accommodation, lunches and coffee breaks on class days, study materials and in-programme cultural visits and social activities.
